

The recommending Joseph's appointment to SC to government'

New Delhi: Justice Jasti Chelameswar has in a letter to Chief Justice of India Dipak Misra said that the collegium must reiterate its recommendation to elevate Uttarakhand chief justice KM Joseph to the Supreme Court.

The second-most senior member of the Supreme Court collegium said in his letter to the CJI on Wednesday that since he was retiring on June 22, the reiteration must be done at the earliest and the file recommending justice KM Joseph's appointment to the Supreme Court sent back to government, ET has learnt.

Chelameswar also mentioned about last Wednesday's collegium meeting, which deferred a decision, and emphasised on the need to protect the independence of the judiciary, a Supreme Court source said.

The collegium had on January 12 recommended justice KM Joseph and senior advocate Indu Malhotra as judges to the Supreme Court. The Union government on April 26 responded to the recommendation by approving the appointment of Indu Malhotra, but returned justice Joseph's file to the collegium for

proposed appointment was not 'appropriate' because there were 'more senior, suitable and deserving chief justices and puisne judges of various high courts.' For the record, justice Joseph is the senior-most high court chief justice at the moment.

In its recommendation in January, the collegium maintained that justice Joseph is "more deserving and suitable in all respects than other chief justices and senior puisne judges of high courts for being appointed as judge of the Supreme Court of India."

In 2017, Justice Chelameswar had described Justice Joseph as "an outstanding and a highly competent judge" and recorded a dissenting note and objected to his non-elevation to the Supreme Court. The Modi government had also not acted on an earlier collegium recommendation for transfer of justice Joseph as chief justice of the Andhra Pradesh high court. Incidentally, Justice Joseph had quashed the Modi government's imposition of President's rule in Uttarakhand in 2016.

His news conference with the other three senior judges had divided the bar down the middle. His attempts to hear petitions filed by a section of lawyers against the CJI, promptly overturned by the latter, also attracted controversy. Rumblyings in SC was not limited to Justice Chelameswar on Wednesday. Justice Arun Mishra, at the receiving end of the 'junior judge' remark and who subsequently

recused himself from hearing the Loya case after expressing his unhappiness at being called a junior judge, made his displeasure known again. He hit out at senior members of the bar on Wednesday for not doing enough to prevent judges from being 'attacked by a section of lawyers'.

In the presence of SC Bar Association president Vikas Singh and a host of other senior advocates, he said: "Who is spared in this court? Every judge is targeted. By one arrow you want to kill all. You people are destroying the institution. If this institution is destroyed, you people won't survive." He then adjourned the case he was hearing. Justice Mishra will be part of the collegium from January 2019.
